There are several reasons the year worked out the way it did. The officers worked well together and you, the members, supported the Lodge. I thank each of you for your efforts and support this year.

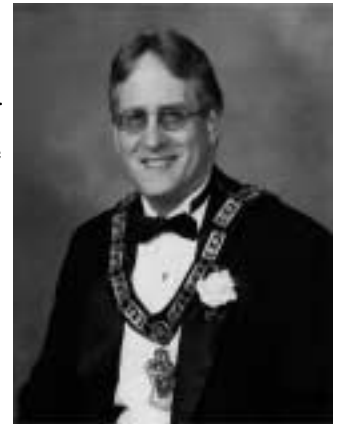
